EFMN will add the event to our online calendar

EFMN will share monthly social media posts directing followers to DIY listings EFMN <u>must</u> approve all printed materials with EFMN logo prior to distribution Contact EFMN for educational resources to share at your event

Donations & Charitable Tax Deductions

For donations to be eligible for a charitable gift tax deduction, they must be made directly to EFMN

Checks should be made payable to the **Epilepsy Foundation of MN** Include the DIY name on the memo line

To receive donations via credit card, the DIY organizer may work with EFMN on available options

EFMN is not able to accept registration fees associated with an event or provide any "pass-thru" funds

EFMN strongly encourages events with registration fees to create a personal bank account

EFMN's 501(c)(3) status may not be used in opening any accounts

EFMN's 501(c)(3) status may not be used to request auction/qiveaway items or grant applications
